Case Summary:

This investigation is the result of Mr. T. [REDACTED] calling the PREA Hotline on 7/19/2018 and 7/20/2018 and reporting allegations against his (Mr. T.) [REDACTED]

Internal Security Investigator II NICOLE VEECH sent an Outlook Message on 7/20/2018 to the Internal Affairs Department at Shawnee Correctional Center, where Mr. T. was housed at that time indicating that he (TATE) had called the hotline. (Attachment #1)

Internal Affairs Lieutenant JERID PICKFORD submitted an Incident Report reflecting that on 7/20/2018 at approximately 3:15 P.M. he (PICKFORD) conducted an interview with Inmate CARL TATE R-12529 due to him (TATE) calling the PREA Hotline. PICKFORD reported during the interview, TATE stated he (TATE) had been sexually assaulted by [REDACTED] on 6/29/2018, at approximately 2:00 AM, while they were celled together in Receiving, Cell-56. PICKFORD reported TATE stated [REDACTED] forced him (TATE) to perform oral sex on him ([REDACTED]) and then penetrated him (TATE) anally with his [REDACTED] penis and finger. Pickford reported he (PICKFORD) immediately contacted Shift Supervisor Major KEVIN REHFUSS, Mental Health Department and the Health Care Unit. PICKFORD reported TATE was seen by Health Care and Mental Health Care. PICKFORD reported TATE was found as not being a risk for suicide potential and returned to his (TATE) assigned cell. (Attachment #2)

The Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) Checklist was obtained and reflects all notifications were completed as required by Shift Supervisor Major KEVIN REHFUSS. (Attachment #3)

The Offender Outpatient Progress Notes for TATE reflect that there was no need indicated for a rape kit to be performed on TATE. (Attachment #4)

Interviews:

Inmate CARL TATE R12529 stated he (TATE) did call the PREA Hotline on 7/19/2018 and 7/20/2018. TATE stated he (TATE) does not understand why [REDACTED] Y19190 cannot be his (TATE) cellmate. TATE stated he (TATE) understands that [REDACTED] was back and forth about being his (TATE) cellmate and that is why the institution is concerned about issues between the two of them. TATE stated he (TATE) has submitted names of inmates that may be possible cellmates with him (TATE). TATE stated some of the names were submitted under duress because he (TATE) was desperate for a cellmate. TATE stated he (TATE) has no answer to what an acceptable solution is to his (TATE) situation. TATE stated he (TATE) submitted [REDACTED] because he [REDACTED] is his (TATE) half-sister's brother. TATE stated once [REDACTED] moved in with him (TATE) in Receiving [REDACTED] started getting mad because he [REDACTED] was not going to get the same movement that he [REDACTED] had in population. TATE stated [REDACTED] was only celled with him (TATE) for two nights. TATE stated the second night they were not let out their cell for church and whatever it was that [REDACTED] was supposed to be let out for. TATE stated he (TATE) had told Mental Health Professional KRISTEN HAMMERSLEY the first day that [REDACTED] was in the cell that he [REDACTED] was not going to work out and that he [REDACTED] was being aggressive. TATE stated the second night [REDACTED] threatened him (TATE) physically and forced him (TATE) to perform oral sex on him [REDACTED]. TATE stated [REDACTED] then penetrated him (TATE) anally with his ([REDACTED] penis and finger. TATE stated this was at approximately 2:00 a.m. TATE stated Correctional Officer RONALD HUTCHISON made rounds and flashed his (HUTCHISON) flashlight through the cell door window. TATE stated ANDERSON had put a blue state shirt over the window. TATE stated [REDACTED] saw the light and immediately got up and sat on the toilet. TATE stated [REDACTED] told him (TATE) to put his (TATE) shorts on. TATE stated HUTCHISON opened the door, took the shirt off of the door and said "if you want to keep your blue shirt keep it off of the door". TATE stated [REDACTED] was naked on the toilet and he (TATE) was naked standing at the back of the cell. TATE stated [REDACTED] had thrown a sheet at him (TATE) to cover up with. TATE stated HUTCHISON was talking to [REDACTED] and did not know how he (HUTCHISON) did not see him (TATE) standing naked at the back of the cell. (Attachment #5)

On 7/21/2018 [REDACTED] was read his Miranda Warning (Constitutional Rights) by Intelligence Officer ZACHERY MOORE. ANDERSON signed the waiver and agreed to speak with MOORE. (Attachment #6)

[REDACTED] stated he ([REDACTED] does not believe that he [REDACTED] was celled with TATE during the time frame that TATE is alleging the incident took place. [REDACTED] stated he [REDACTED] doesn't understand why TATE is making these claims against him [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated the night TATE is claiming he ([REDACTED] sexually assaulted him (TATE) he [REDACTED] does recall the officer opening the cell door because he [REDACTED] did have a state blue shirt covering the cell door window. [REDACTED] stated that he [REDACTED] had the shirt on the door because he [REDACTED] was on the toilet. [REDACTED] stated that the officer stood in the doorway for a couple of minutes and explained that he [REDACTED] could not cover the cell window. [REDACTED] stated that during this time TATE was standing at the back of the cell and then reached forward and took the shirt from the officer. [REDACTED] stated TATE was fully clothed while the officer was talking to him [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that if TATE was standing in the cell naked the officer would have noticed it. [REDACTED] stated the next day after the toilet incident he [REDACTED] recalls TATE had an attorney call and went to speak to Mental Health. [REDACTED] stated TATE was placed on Suicide Watch after speaking with Mental Health. [REDACTED] stated he [REDACTED] went to talk to TATE while he (TATE) was on watch and during this conversation [REDACTED] stated that TATE said that they could not be cellmates anymore because of something in [REDACTED] background. [REDACTED] stated he

██████████ told TATE the only thing he (██████████) could think of was because another inmate had filed a PREA complaint against him (██████████). ██████████ stated that during the conversation TATE gave ██████████ his (TATE) PIN number so that ██████████ could call TATE'S sister and explain his (TATE) situation. ██████████ stated he (██████████) made the call to TATE'S sister that day, then came and told TATE that he (██████████) had got in contact with his (TATE) sister. ██████████ stated TATE asked him (██████████) to call his (TATE) sister back and explain their family connection. ██████████ stated after that day he (██████████) only had minimal conversation with TATE until he (██████████) was moved back out into population. ██████████ stated he (██████████) does not fear for his safety at Shawnee C.C. ██████████ stated that he (██████████) would like to speak to Mental Health about the situation, but does not have any thoughts of harming himself (██████████) or others. (Attachment #7)

Correctional Officer RONALD HUTCHISON stated he (HUTCHISON) did know who Inmate CARL TATE R-12529 was. HUTCHISON stated he (HUTCHISON) did remember when TATE was celled with ██████████ in Receiving. HUTCHISON stated he (HUTCHISON) was making rounds one night in Receiving and saw what appeared to be an inmate's shirt hanging over the cell door window of Cell-56. HUTCHISON stated he (HUTCHISON) opened the door to tell TATE and A██████████ to take it down. HUTCHISON stated when he (HUTCHISON) opened the door ██████████ was sitting on the toilet with no shirt on. HUTCHISON stated he (HUTCHISON) then made a blanket statement to both inmates to take the shirt down and they said OK. HUTCHISON stated he (HUTCHISON) then noticed inmate TATE standing at the back of the cell with his (TATE) back towards him (HUTCHISON). HUTCHISON stated TATE had no shirt on but did have shorts on. HUTCHISON stated he (HUTCHISON) did make several more rounds that night checking on the receiving cells and there were no issues with TATE and ██████████ (Attachment #8)

██████████ stated he (██████████) was assigned to cell Rec-57. ██████████ stated during the dates of 6/29/18 he was assigned to cell Rec-57. ██████████ stated during his (██████████) time in cell Rec-57, he (██████████) had never heard anything coming from cell Rec-56. ██████████ stated he (██████████) had never heard any sounds of duress, ██████████ stated he (██████████) is unaware of anything that may have taken place in cell Rec-56. (Attachment #9)

Mental Health Professional SYDELL FULK stated inmate CARL TATE R12529 had been on her (FULK) caseload since she (FULK) started working at Shawnee Correctional Center in April of 2018. FULK stated she (FULK) never saw any bruising or swelling on TATE during her (FULK) sessions with him (TATE). FULK stated TATE never told her (FULK) anything about a sexual assault that happened to him (TATE) while he (TATE) was in Receiving. (Attachment #10)

Conclusion:

Based on the lack of direct evidence and witness statements, the allegation that ██████████ forced Inmate CARL TATE R12529 perform sexual acts on ██████████ and with him (██████████) was found to be unsubstantiated.

On 7/21/2018 [REDACTED] was interviewed in regards to the PREA complaint made against him ([REDACTED]) by TATE, CARL R12529. [REDACTED] stated that he [REDACTED] does not believe that he [REDACTED] was celled with TATE during the time frame that TATE is alleging the incident took place. [REDACTED] ON stated that he (ANDERSON) doesn't understand why TATE is making these claims against him [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that the night TATE is claiming he [REDACTED] sexually assaulted him (TATE) he [REDACTED] does recall the officer opening the cell door because he [REDACTED] did have a state blue shirt covering the cell door window. [REDACTED] stated that he ([REDACTED]) had the shirt on the door because he [REDACTED] was on the toilet. [REDACTED] stated that the officer stood in the doorway for a couple of minutes and explained that he ([REDACTED]) could not cover the cell window. HUTCHISON stated he (HUTCHISON) was making rounds one night in Receiving and saw what appeared to be an inmates shirt hanging over the cell door window of Cell-56.
